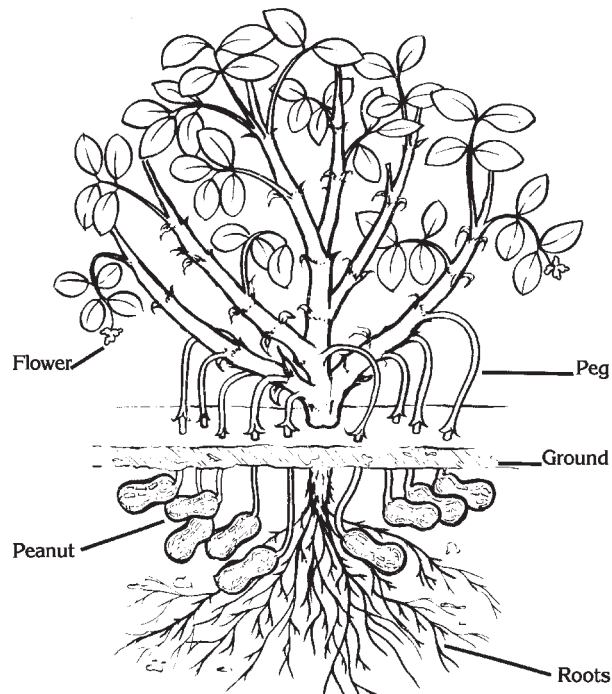
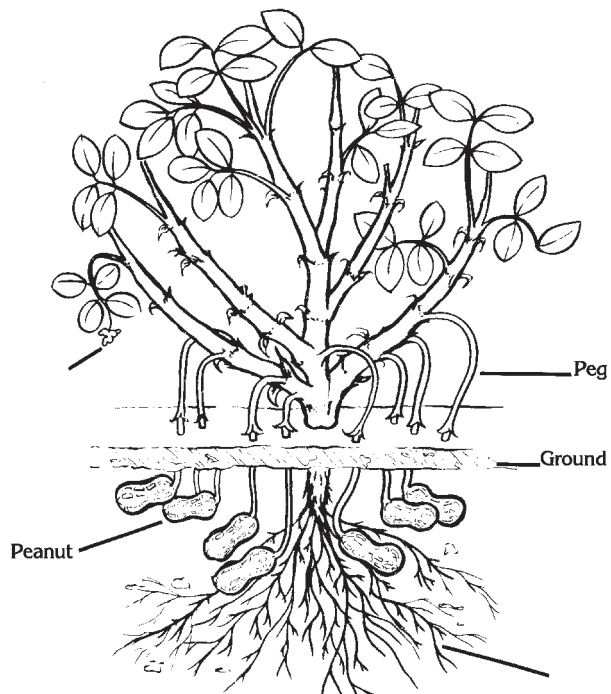


**PARTS OF PLANT B ARE MISSING!

Step 1: Peanut seeds are planted in May. (The peanut we eat is the seed.)

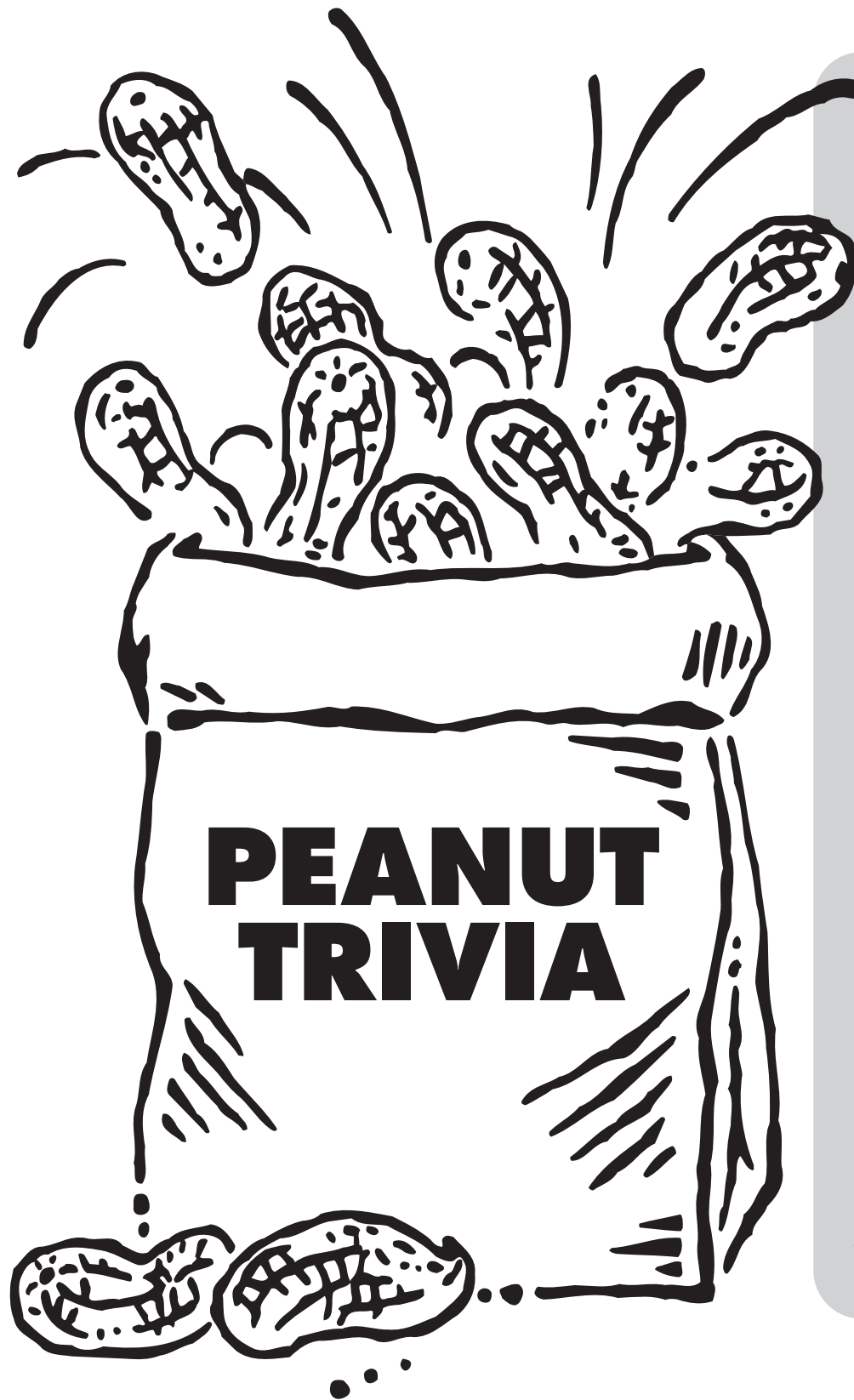
Step 2: Roots begin to grow; within 6-7 days the plant can be seen.

Step 3: Branches form and the plant begins to bloom 4-6 weeks later.

Step 4: Flowers fade and in 6 weeks pegs begin to appear. Pegs drop down into soil.

Step 5: Peanuts begin to grow at the end of the pegs and are harvested in October.

PEANUTS



It takes 850 peanuts to make one 18 ounce jar of peanut butter.

Two presidents of the USA, Jimmy Carter and Thomas Jefferson, were peanut farmers. Carter also earned a nuclear engineering degree at Annapolis.

The world's largest peanut monument is 20 feet tall, and it's currently kept in Turner County, Georgia.

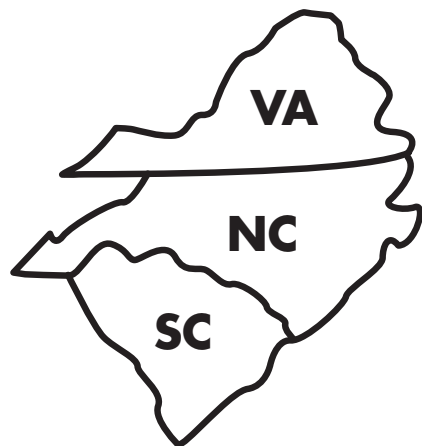
One acre of peanut crop yields 3,400 pounds of peanuts, enough to make 30,000 peanut butter sandwiches.
